♦ What Is Tokyo Midtown DESIGN TOUCH?

Tokyo Midtown DESIGN TOUCH is a design festival which has been held since 2007 under the concept of "enjoying design with all five senses." Designers working on the frontline of design and designers attracting attention from Japan and overseas come together at Tokyo Midtown for this festival. It is an event where everyone can experience the attractions and possibilities of design up-close.

This Year's Theme

This year's theme is "Meguru Design – Design for Sustainable Future." The Umi no Hammock (Sea Hammock) large-scale installation in the motif of the sea, one of the highlights of this exhibition, will place marine pollution and marine garbage, which has become a problem that affects the ecosystem, in a circular design. The REAMIDE fiber circular material has been adopted for this installation as an attempt to connect to people as a "circulating" object.
