# **Notice of Acquisition of ISCC PLUS Certification**

(Head Office: Chiyoda-ku, Tokyo; President: Akira Ochi) is pleased to announce that it has become the first company in Japan\*1 to receive ISCC PLUS certification, an international certification system for sustainable products, as a collector of waste plastics used as raw materials for petrochemical recycling.

This certification will enable the supply of renewable resources through an internationally certified supply chain.

We will promote the supply of raw materials for chemical recycling using the mass balance method, which is expected to expand in the future and contribute to the resource recycling of waste plastics.

Refineverse, Inc. commits and declares its compliance with the requirements for ISCC PLUS certification following the latest ISCC regulations.

## ■ ISCC PLUS Certification

The ISCC (International Sustainability and Carbon Certification) PLUS Certification, developed by ISCC, is a third-party certification that certifies that the supply chain of recyclable raw materials and products such as biomass, waste, and residues from agriculture and forestry, is properly managed. This certification enables us to strengthen our sustainable resource management and promote new initiatives to reduce environmental impact.

### Mass balance method

The mass balance method is a distribution management method that assigns a percentage of raw materials procured from specific businesses to products for manufacturing and distribution. This method makes it possible to track the amount of raw materials of recycled origin used in products manufactured and sold.

Refineverse Group, Inc. will continue to promote resource recycling and work toward the realization of a decarbonized society.
