Commenced Demonstration Testing of a Generative AI Recommendation System Joint development began in November with BAKUTAN, a "Go-en Tech" startup from the University of Tokyo

(Head Office: Setagaya-ku, Tokyo; CEO: Shudai Komoriya) have begun developing and testing a recommendation system powered by generative AI. This system accelerates business matching within organizations, fostering connections that address sustainability challenges.

Background of the Project

Refinverse Group has been at the forefront of circular economy practices for over 20 years, pioneering initiatives like horizontal recycling of discarded carpet tiles from offices and facilities, and the repurposing of waste materials such as fishing nets, vehicle airbags, and bird feathers. Over the years, the company has built a robust network of sustainability-focused professionals. This network, developed through decades of collaboration, is a unique strength and serves as a vital resource in addressing current ESG and sustainability challenges.

As part of its long-term strategy, Refinverse Group established the "Circular Economy Platform Concept" to support projects in various fields tackling sustainability and ESG issues. 


Image of demonstration experiment implementation
