### **Announcement Regarding Factory Relocation Due to Business Expansion**

Refineverse, Inc. (Head Office: Chiyoda-ku, Tokyo; President: Akira Ochi) is pleased to announce that it has decided to relocate its “Ichinomiya Factory” in Ichinomiya City, Aichi Prefecture—which manufactures REAMIDE®, a recycled nylon material made from discarded fishing nets and airbags—to Gamagori City, Aichi Prefecture, and to commence operations at the new “Gamagori Factory” in June 2026.

#### **■ Relocation to the “Gamagori Factory”**

Since establishing the Ichinomiya Factory in 2019, the Company has been engaged in the recycling of discarded fishing nets and airbags into REAMIDE®, a recycled nylon material. Applications for REAMIDE® continue to expand across building materials, agricultural machinery, apparel products, office furniture, and more.

As part of the Company’s growth strategy outlined in its medium-term management plan—including the planned expansion into polyolefin recycling—the decision was made to relocate to Gamagori City, which offers sufficient room for future operational growth as a manufacturing base.

At the Gamagori Factory, the Company will inherit the equipment operations and know-how cultivated at the Ichinomiya Factory, continue manufacturing REAMIDE®, and proceed step-by-step with installing the necessary facilities to launch polyolefin recycling. Operations are scheduled to begin in June 2026.
